# Brighter Prospects

## Courses to suit the learner and employers' needs

Brighter Prospects is individualised personal training for young people aged 16-24 across Lancashire who are in employment. The training can be 10, 20 or 30 hours in duration, depending on the needs of the employee.

Funded by the European Social Fund, Lancashire Adult Learning is working with Skelmersdale and Ormskirk College on this project which is designed to encourage young people back into learning, to enhance their skills and to help them to progress onto further learning/training, which will improve their employment options.

After completion of this training, learners will be offered further opportunities including Apprenticeships, Skills for Life, Further Education or additional training to enhance their careers and develop their skills.

Working with employers, Lancashire Adult Learning can offer courses to suit the learner and employers' needs. The content of the course will be individualised and will include sector specific training.

Each course would include aspects of personal learning and thinking skills:

- 10 hours would focus on personal development with a small aspect of occupational competence
  - 20 hours Vocational and Personal Development
- 30 hours QCF unit of competence or knowledge depending on occupational area plus personal development
